

Uniform Guide

What should my child wear at the Academy?

Tudor Grange Primary Academy Hockley Heath are very proud of the standards it maintains with uniform. This is achieved through the partnership between the Academy and home. To enable you to support the Academy the full uniform requirements are listed below:

Uniform - EYFS



- Bottle green sweatshirt
- White polo shirt
- PE top and shorts
- Grey trousers/skirts/pinafores
- Black shoes
- Indoor pumps
- Wellies
- Outdoor trainers
- Outdoor coat
- School Book Bag

Separate bag for PE kit and spare clothes, which could be a pump bag or another bag fit for purpose.

Bags should be of a discreet colour and design. This bag will stay at school during the week.

Uniform – Years 1 – 6



Blazer



Grey V-neck Jumper



Clip-on-tie

White school shirt must be able to be buttoned up to collar, and with enough material allowance to remain tucked into the waistband.

Grey skirt or trousers.

Plain white / grey socks or grey tights. No patterned tights allowed.

Plain grey or black socks if wearing trousers.

Sensible school shoes – black.



School book bag or a bag fit for purpose. Bags should be of a discreet colour and design.

A suitable pump bag should be used to carry PE kits, this needs to be able to fit all kit inside.

NB – sandals are not allowed

- Plain black / dark grey / bottle green tracksuit pants (not leggings) and / or sweatshirt hoodie with no obvious branding are acceptable for outdoor PE in cold weather. These do not replace the sports top / shorts which must be worn underneath.
- Black pumps
- Trainers for outdoor games
- Swimming costume (for relevant year groups)
- Swimming cap for students with long hair (for relevant year groups)

Non-participation and other information

If students are unable to participate in a practical lesson they will be expected to bring their kit and assume an officiating or other supporting role, which does not compromise their health.

Summer Uniform

As part of our summer school uniform pupils are able to wear summer dresses throughout the summer months.

As an alternative to summer dresses, pupils are able to wear short sleeved shirts with a school tie, and grey school shorts. Pupils should continue to wear blazers when travelling to and from school when wearing summer uniform.

Coats

Plain dark coats (grey, dark green, dark navy blue or black) with no obvious logos, branding, stripes, slogans or designs. A minimal fur trim is acceptable. Hoodies and sleeveless coats are not permitted.

Jewellery

In the interests of safety and security children should not wear jewellery. If earrings are worn, only one pair of plain gold/silver studs are permitted. These should be removed for PE, games and swimming. If the pupil is unable to remove them themselves this should be done at home. We advise that piercings, if desired, take place at the beginning of the summer holidays. This will allow enough time before the piercings are removed for the above activities from September onwards.

Hairstyles

Extreme hairstyles, cut and colour are not allowed on any occasion. Examples of extreme hairstyles would include close shaved (less than a number 2 cut), or decoratively shaved. Two tone colouring, extensive highlighting and decorative braiding are not allowed. Hair below the collar should be tied back and hair ties, if worn, should be black, dark brown or bottle green. All hair accessories, including hairbands and slides, should be of a discreet size and must be either black, dark brown or bottle green. The school supports and welcomes pupils with afro-textured hair to wear their hair in styles which promote the maintenance and upkeep, without fear of penalisation.

Turbans

Black, dark grey or dark bottle green in colour.

Hijabs

Black, dark grey or dark bottle green in colour. To be pinned under the chin to stay on the head comfortably.

Hats

Plain black or dark hats. Hats permitted only during extreme weather.

All uniform must be clearly labelled please.

Where we encourage children to wear uniform with their school logo this is not mandatory. All uniform must adhere to the designated item colour but does not have to include the school logo.

School will host a pre-worn uniform during the last week of each term. Parents are asked to donate a contribution to the school's library fund for the purchase of new library books for items taken. We encourage all families to donate used uniform in good condition to support this process.
