

## Remote Acceptable Use Agreement for Parents/Carers and Pupils

Our online platforms are monitored, which will provide protection to both staff and students. Please read the Remote Learning Agreement bullet points to the right with your child. It is advisable for parents and carers to monitor online behaviour of their children, and set age-appropriate parental controls on digital devices and use internet filters to block malicious websites. These are usually free, but often need to be turned on.

### Remote learning agreement for Pupils

- My behaviour on line should be as it is during lessons in school.
- I will be respectful towards my teachers and other pupils at all times.
- I will not copy anything from Purple Mash, school emails, Microsoft Teams or other platforms used by teachers, and place on any other on-line platform or social media.
- I will not record any part of an audio or video call.
- I will maintain the same standards of expectation when using technology at home as I would do in school knowing that platforms used by teachers are monitored.
- I understand that my teacher will record any live video calls to ensure the safety of all pupils and staff involved.
- I understand that my face may be on the screen during live video lessons or my teacher might ask me to turn my camera off.
- If I am involved in a live lesson, I will keep my microphone muted, unless my teacher states otherwise.
- I understand that only the teacher will have the ability to schedule any form of live lesson, and this will be by invite only so that the pupils joining are monitored.
