

# **Before School Club**

Double H opens at 7.45am each week day and provides parents with the facility to drop their child with us before school starts. At breakfast club, children can enjoy a relaxed atmosphere before going to school. Toast is served for breakfast if desired, and a selection of fruit is always avail-

Each morning there is a selection of activities available for the children such as:

- Jigsaws, puzzles and board games
- Role play activities
- Reading Books
- Construction Toys
- Art and Craft activities



## **After School Club**

The emphasis of after school club is on providing a nurturing, friendly and happy end to the day with a balance between active, sporty exercise and more focused creative activities, indoor games and homework. Children are encouraged to take part in different activities alongside their peers, but it is also recognised that this is the children's recreational time where free play or relaxation may be preferred.

### Structure.

Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 children are collected from their classrooms, Key Stage 2 children make their own way through school to Double H club. All children are registered on arrival and are offered a drink and snack. Fruit is available at all times for children to help themselves.

There is a wide choice of activities for the children to choose from including:

- Art and craft activities
- Fancy dress /role play props
- Outdoor play equipment
- Baking
- Board games / group games
- ICT activities
- Relaxation time with friends





For children staying after 4.30pm, we provide a light tea served around 5.00pm. The children are encouraged to take an active role to help prepare the tea, clear away after themselves and for older children to support our younger pupils.
