

## Year 4 Summer 1

### Maths:

This term we will be covering the following:

- Fractions
- Decimals
- Money

Please continue to focus on our weekly times tables that are posted on the Purple Mash blog and our KIRF (which is also a times tables focus).



### Science:

We are looking at living things including their habitats. We will work through the unit to then answer the following investigative question: to classify a variety of animals

### Art:

We are focussing on famous buildings, linking specifically to the architecture of Sir Christopher Wren. Using what they have learnt the children will design a building for a particular purpose, chosen by them.

### PE:

Monday- Pupils will play cricket, ran and supported by Chance to Shine.  
Tuesday- Pupils will develop their handball skills with our PE coach.

*Pupils will be coming home in their PE kits on a Tuesday- these need to be back in school by Monday.*

### Computing:

We will be creating pieces of media, including photo editing.

### Latin:

We will continue to learn how to use Latin nouns, verbs and adverbs to translate Latin sentences.

### English & Spellings:

We will be starting with a non-fiction play script based on the Plague village- Eyam. Then we will move onto the book 'Gut Garden- A Journey into the Wonderful World of your Microbiome' by Katie Brosnan, which explores the digestive system.



We will continue to have a weekly spelling focus and CEWs sent home for testing on a Friday.

### Guided reading:

Our focus texts will be 'Kick' followed by 'Romeo and Juliet'. We will be working on the VIPER skills throughout our lessons. We will also continue to read a variety of books as part of our morning REAL reading sessions.

### Geography:

We will be learning about rivers and where our water comes from; this will be supported by a trip to Sarehole Mill where the children will take part in a river fieldwork workshop.

### RE:

We will be looking at Judaism and how special the relationship is that Jewish people have with God.

### Music:

We will be looking at the pentatonic scale and different music traditions within different cultures.

### PSHE:

We will be exploring the topic of relationships.

### Enrichment:

Pupils will be going to Sarehole Mill to complete a workshop on rivers, to support them with their geography topic.
